



## Recipe of the Month—Open-Faced Sandwhiches

The open-faced sandwich has a long tradition in Norway. A slice of freshly cut bread, thinly spread with butter, provides the base for artfully arranged toppings and edible garnishes. Every element of the sandwich should be fresh. The ingredients should complement one another with respect both to taste and appearance.



#### Suggestions for Sandwich types

- 1. Smoked salmon slices on a slice of white bread, with scrambled egg or hard-cooked egg wedges and dill.
- 2. Shelled shrimp or crabmeat on toast, with mayonnaise and lemon.
- 3. Sardines in tomato sauce on whole wheat bread, with hard-cooked egg slices and fresh dill.
- 4. Anchovy fillets on whole wheat bread with raw egg yolk placed in an onion ring, sprinkled with chopped chives.
- 5. Roast reindeer meat on whole wheat bread with poached apple wedges and lingonberry preserves.
- 6. Sautéed minute steak on whole wheat bread with leek rings, tomato and parsley.
- 7. Cured ham on whole wheat bread with scrambled eggs.
- 8. Headcheese on whole wheat bread with pickled beets and pickled cucumbers.
- 9. Gamalost on whole wheat bread with butter and parsley.
- 10. Ship's plank with shrimp, eggs, cheese and boiled ham.

# Scandi sweep the 2019 Bocuse d'Or

At the 17<sup>th</sup> <u>Bocuse d'Or</u>, a prestigious culinary competition in France, Scandinavian countries swept <u>all three podium spots</u>. Out of 24 countries, teams <u>Denmark</u>, Sweden and Norway won the gold, silver and bronze awards.

The chefs prepared two French classics: <u>roasted rack of veal</u>, and chartreuse with shellfish.



Christian André Pettersen, decorated chef of Team Norway, grew up in Bodø and heads the kitchen at <u>Mondo</u>in Sandnes. He started cooking in his father's restaurant at age nine and has dreamed of winning Bocuse since he was a boy. Pettersen says competition fuels him and that he plans to go for the gold in 2021.



Arlee Lee, secretary of the American Legion #1771 Auxillary in Lafayette, CO, has came thru again with 9,651 stamps for Tubfrim. They have ladies through out the U.S. and in Colorado sending stamps to them and they in send them on to us. In the last 5 years they have sent us 63,417 stamps. With their help we have sent 60 pounds of stamps to Norway in the last 5 years. A good friend of Lloyds (now deceased) also provided over 100 en-



velopes with stamps which were over 40 years old (1909 and later). These were sent to Norway with stamps attached in our Nov, 2018 mailing.

Tubfrim winner announced

Sons of Norway is very excited to announce that Trollheim 1-511 in St. Cloud, MN is the winner of the Tubfrim drawing to give away a ticket to Norway, worth up to \$1,000. Their postcard was drawn from among 876 cards. With one card for every pound of stamps sent to Norway, that means that Sons of Norway sent at least 876 pounds or approximately 1,314,000 stamps to Tubfrim in 2018. During this past year, 73 lodges participated in the program.




The Fjelldalen gift card that you reload will no longer be active.


#### SPESIELLE INTERESSEGRUPPER







