

Matpakke

This word means something close to "packed lunch". But what makes it difficult to translate is the exact composition of the lunch that the word often entails.

A traditional Norwegian matpakke consists of several slices of bread garnished with pålegg (roughly pronounced paw-leg) and sometimes a piece of fruit or some raw vegetables. The bread used is whole grain and quite dense when compared to standard US, UK or French bread.

Pålegg

Pålegg literally translates as "on-layer". But what it really means is "stuff you put on bread". Spreads such as peanut butter, jam, Nutella, cream cheese and liver paté are all pålegg. Sliced meats and cheeses, smoked fish, hard boiled eggs and sardines all fall under the umbrella term of pålegg.



Almond Bars

Ingredients Bars:

1/2 cup butter, softened1 cup sugar1 egg1/2 tsp. almond extract1 3/4 cups flour1/4 tsp. salt2 tsp. baking powder2 Tbsp. milk1/2 cup

sliced almonds

Glaze:

2 cups powdered sugar 1/2 cup milk 1/2 tsp. almond extract

Directions:

- Preheat oven to 325° F / 165°C. Line baking sheets with silpat pads or parchment paper.
- In a mixing bowl, cream together the softened butter and sugar.
- Add the egg and almond extract and beat until mixture is fluffy.
- Add the flour, baking powder and salt until you have a soft dough.
- Divide the dough into four parts. Roll each part into an 8-inch log.
- Place on prepared cookie sheets and flatten each log to 3 inches / 8 cm wide with your hands. Leave 4 inches / 10 cm or so between each rectangular bar.
- Brush the tops with the milk and sprinkle on sliced almonds.
- Bake for 15-20 minutes, or until edges are slightly browned.
- While still slightly warm, cut crosswise into 1-inch-wide diagonal bars.
- Cool, and then drizzle with glaze.
- Glaze: In a bowl, beat together powdered sugar, milk and almond extract until smooth.
- Drizzle glaze over diagonal sections

Shrimp Canapés Serves 4

Ingredients:

16 slices bread 1/2 cup mayo 1/4 cup butter, softened
1 small jar capers 4 large sprigs fresh dill 1 lemon, sliced in half moons
20 boiled, cold shrimp, preferably still in the shell or head on

Method:

Boil the shrimp. jumbo take 7-8 minutes. (Small shrimp will only need 3-4 minutes). Shock in ice water to keep them from overcooking. Drain.

Lay out all ingredients in a DIY spread. Instead of using traditional white bread, I used slices of soft wheat bread cut into dainty circles with cutters. I loaded my canapes up with the salty capers, a splash of lemon juice and a sprig of dill. It was fun assembling each sandwich.

When buying tickets for the Syttnede Mai picnic or our Lutefisk dinner or even just making a lodge donation, the lodge's Zelle contact is Amber Gardner at 720-394-8304 or email her at treasurer@fjelldalen.com with questions.



What is Zelle:

Zelle is a money transfer service that is set up through most financial institutions. It pulls directly from your account to send money with no charge instantly (in most cases) to friends and family using their phone number or email address. They can also send money directly into your account using the contact method that is linked to your account through your online banking. Your financial institution should be able to help you enroll or answer any questions. Or go to https://zellepay.com.

How it works:

Behind the scenes on your online banking profile with a bank that participates in Zelle you'd link your phone number or email address to your account. This way, instead of providing people with account and routing numbers, you give them the contact information that you have linked in order to receive the money, which is a safer exchange of information.

Words of caution:

- Do not send money via Zelle to anyone you do not know. Zelle works like cash and rarely has dispute rights.
- Take the time to read the new recipient message and the "Enrolled as..." name displayed in the Zelle pop-up when transferring money to a new contact.
- The only piece of information that someone needs to send funds is a phone number or an email address. It's a red flag for anyone to ask for an account, card number, user ID, password, Social Security, etc.
- Scams abound, especially during the holiday season, so be wary and keep in mind that if a transaction sounds too good to be true, it probably is.
- Call your bank to report if you have fallen victim to Zelle fraud.
