

From the Sons of Norway Headquarters

As a Sons of Norway leader, we wanted to share with you some information regarding the financial status and operations of the organization impacted by recent decisions. Action had to be taken for the long-term financial health and vibrancy of Sons of Norway, so the organization will endure for another 128 years. These transactions increased our capital to better position Sons of Norway's financial strength and our prospects for future growth.

Our surplus, a measure of solvency equal to the owner's equity in accounting terms, has been reduced to a critical level in recent years. A healthy surplus level is required by the Minnesota Department of Commerce (MDOC), to continue as a viable carrier and ensure we have the capital to support future claims. To return our surplus to acceptable levels it was necessary to make changes, including increasing the level of surplus capital, reducing overall expenses, and continuing to price and implement insurance and annuity products with increased profitability and sales potential.

Sons of Norway recently announced the next step in our journey to profitability with the closure of sales of our guaranteed issue whole life (GIWL) product in the fourth quarter of 2022. This change was necessitated by several factors such as higher than expected claims and adverse economic and market conditions that ultimately caused higher than acceptable capital strain or cost to the organization. This strain, in conjunction with the immediate reduction of new sales due to this closure, has forced us to make some very difficult decisions:

- Regrettably, effective January 12, 2023, Sons of Norway has reduced our home office staff by 20%. The core team that remains will
 spend 2023 building a new normal for Sons of Norway that focuses on streamlined processes, steady but measured growth, and
 modernizing technologies.
- We have ceased sales of GIWL products, we will be introducing a new suite of life products later in 2023.
- We sold the royalty rights to some gas and oil lease investments.
- We entered into a reinsurance arrangement for a block of annuities.

We will continue to evaluate our expenses and leverage technology to ensure we are operating as efficiently as possible. An early review of our year-end 2022 financials indicates a **PROFIT** of \$3.941 million, assets of \$233.3 million resulting in a **surplus of \$13.5** million. We are pleased that Sons of Norway realized an increase to our surplus for 2022. While this is a positive step, it is still necessary to address the ongoing level of income provided by our insurance products and to reduce our long-term expenses to a level appropriate to an organization our size. Not doing so over the last few decades has led us to circumstances in which we have lower net income and annual losses. While we work our way out of this situation by lowering expenses and increasing profitable insurance sales, net losses for the next few years are possible.

We encourage you to watch for the June issue of *Viking* magazine for a more detailed report on the financial stability of Sons of Norway and the complete balance sheet.

From District 6

The District Six Zoom Seminar that was held on April 5th, 2023. International Director Luella Grangaard was in charge of the Zoom Meeting with President Lis Barca, Vice President Laurie Mittelstadt and Secretary Nancy Madson present. In total there were twenty-four District 6 Lodge members present representing a few different zones. The majority of the lodge members were from California and Arizona and one lodge member was from Colorado.

International Director Luella Grangaard spoke on numerous topics and goals for District Six to complete during the year. One of the biggest news items that Luella Grangaard spoke about was the District Six Convention that will be held in June and on dates 20th – 24th 2024 in Las Vegas, Nevada. The location will be at the Tuscany Suites & Casino, 255 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada. This hotel is located just two blocks from the Las Vegas strip.

Luella Grangaard also spoke about goals for the different Lodges and for the Lodges to have one "extra" event outside of the regular Lodge meetings each month.

The District Six website https://sofn6.org and Sons of Norway website https://www.sofn.com were discussed during the seminar. Members are strongly encouraged to look through both websites as they have been redesigned and have additional resources.

also ran the A1 fire fighting crew for the Region 5 of the Forest Service and worked on many major fires including several at Yellowstone Park.





Kålruller—Norwegian Cabbage Rolls

Ingredients:

2 medium-sized heads of cabbage 1½ tsp. salt

1/4 tsp. nutmeg, ground

1 egg

1 can crushed tomatoes

1/2 lb. ground beef 1/4 tsp. pepper

1/4 tsp. ginger, ground

2 Tbsp. heavy cream

salt and pepper for additional seasoning



- 1. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil and then add one whole head of cabbage and allow it to boil for 5-7 minutes, or until the outer layers turn slightly transparent.
- 2. Remove the entire head of cabbage from the water and allow it to cool off on a baking sheet until cool enough to handle. Repeat the same process for each head of cabbage.
- 3. Once the cabbage has cooled off enough to touch with your bare hands, remove the leaves from the core. They should be quite flexible and easily malleable, but if you get some resistance from the vein of the cabbage leaf when you try to bend it, shave it down with a paring knife.
- 4. To make the meat filling, combine the beef, salt, all spices, egg and cream into a bowl. Using your hands or a large spoon, combine the ingredients until well incorporated.
- 5. Next, add a lump of filling into the middle of the leaf, and wrap the edges of the leaf around the meat to form a parcel or mini-burrito. Repeat this process until all the meat and leaves have been used.
- 6. Place all of your cabbage parcels into a baking dish. Pour the crushed tomatoes over the top, season to taste with salt and pepper, and bake in an oven pre-heated to 190°C/375°F for 35-40 minutes, or until the tomatoes bubble into a sauce.
- 7. Serve warm with boiled potatoes

Fiskegrateng – Fish au gratin

Ingredients:

1 pound white fish fillets, poached 1/3 cup margarine

1/2 cup white flour 2 cups milk

1 tsp. salt 1/8 tsp. pepper

3 eggs, beaten buttered breadcrumbs or grated cheese

Directions:

- 1. Flake the poached fish into a well-greased baking dish
- 2. In a small saucepan, melt margarine and add 1/2 cup flour
- 3. Gradually add the milk, salt, pepper and beaten eggs
- 4. Beat thoroughly until smooth and lump-free
- 5. Pour over fish and top with a layer of buttered breadcrumbs OR grated cheese.
- 6. Bake at 175°C (350°F) for 45 minutes.



What is Zelle:

Zelle is a money transfer service that is set up through most financial institutions. It pulls directly from your account to send money with no charge instantly (in most cases) to friends and family using their phone number or email address. They can also send money directly into your account using the contact method that is linked to your account through your online banking. Your financial institution should be able to help you enroll or answer any questions. Or go to https://zellepay.com.

How it works:

Behind the scenes on your online banking profile with a bank that participates in Zelle you'd link your phone number or email address to your account. This way, instead of providing people with account and routing numbers, you give them the contact information that you have linked in order to receive the money, which is a safer exchange of information.

Words of caution:


- Do not send money via Zelle to anyone you do not know. Zelle works like cash and rarely has dispute rights.
- Take the time to read the new recipient message and the "Enrolled as..." name displayed in the Zelle pop-up when transferring money to a new contact.
- The only piece of information that someone needs to send funds is a phone number or an email address. It's a red flag for anyone to ask for an account, card number, user ID, password, Social Security, etc.
- Scams abound, especially during the holiday season, so be wary and keep in mind that if a transaction sounds too good to be true, it probably is.
- Call your bank to report if you have fallen victim to Zelle fraud.
